News on the 4th CONTECSI: The 4th CONTECSI is close; it is going to take place on May 30th and 31st and on June 1st, 2007, at FEA USP, São Paulo, Brazil. This edition of CONTECSI exceeds the previous ones in numbers of papers, totaling 300, which represents 43% more papers than the 3rd CONTECSI, with authors from 14 countries and 18 Brazilian states. Two hundred and fifteen papers out of the total of 300 papers were chosen to be presented in parallel sessions and at the research forum, and, for the first time, there will be a doctoral consortium.
